

General Information

- A total of 1,683 companion animals were provided care and services through SCAC
- 9,348 people visited the shelter and 5,218 phone calls received during public hours
- 1,021 surgeries were completed onsite by staff veterinarians

Shelter Services

- 783 companion animals were cared for at the shelter facility
- 738 companion animals were new arrivals to the shelter
- 560 companion animals were adopted
- 509 shelter animals underwent surgery (spays/neuters, dentals, minor surgeries)
- 10 canines were surrendered through ACOs and/or Law Enforcement agencies
- 57 vaccines (rabies) were administered at the public vaccine clinic

Community Programs

- **513** pet cats were spayed/neutered through SNAP*
 - o 451 pet cats
 - o 56 rescued community cats from *Hearts of Nine* feline rescue
 - o 6 fee-waived surgeries
- 2 community cats were spayed/neutered through TNR**
- 137 pet dogs were spayed/neutered through SNAP*
- **190** pets were fed through our Pet Food Pantry
 - 178 bags of dog food
 - 239 bags of cat food
 - 142 bags of cat litter
 - 95 families accessed this program
- 58 pets received emergency veterinary care through our Angel Fund
- 251 volunteers contributed more than 2,500 hours to help SCAC
 - o 211 volunteers spent 2,336 hours at the shelter
 - o 30 volunteers spent 120 hours providing short-term foster care to kittens
 - 10 volunteers opened their homes to provide long-term foster care to dogs and cats with chronic illnesses
