

Community Impact Report 2020

General Information

- A total of 1,531 companion animals were provided care and services through SCAC
- 984 surgeries were completed onsite by staff veterinarians
- Note: Visitors and phone calls were not tallied during 2020 due to limited staff resources.

Shelter Services

- 577 companion animals were cared for at the shelter facility
- 540 companion animals were new arrivals to the shelter
- 452 companion animals were adopted
- 391 shelter animals underwent surgery (spays/neuters, dentals, minor surgeries)
- 10 canines were surrendered through regional Animal Control Officers and/or Law Enforcement agencies
- Due to the COVID pandemic, the public vaccine clinic was cancelled

Community Programs

- 492 pet/public cats were spayed/neutered through SNAP*
 - o 418 owned/pet cats
 - o 74 rescued community cats from *Hearts of Nine* feline rescue
- 30 community cats were spayed/neutered through TNR**
- 122 pet dogs were spayed/neutered through SNAP*
 - o 41 completed onsite at SCAC
 - o 81 completed offsite by participating area veterinarians
- 300 pets were fed through the Pet Food Pantry
 - o 169 bags of dog food
 - o 155 bags of cat food
 - o 71 bags of cat litter
 - o 100 families accessed this program
- 10 pets received emergency veterinary care through our Angel Fund
- 117 volunteers contributed 847 hours to help SCAC
 - o 67 adult and youth volunteers spent 647 hours at the shelter
 - o 50 volunteers spent 200 hours providing short-term foster care to kittens
 - o 7 volunteers opened their homes to provide long-term, daily foster care to dogs and cats with chronic illnesses
