

## Community Impact Report 2021

## **General Information**

- A total of 1,715 companion animals were provided care and services through SCAC
- A total of 1,119 surgeries were completed onsite by staff veterinarians
- Note: Visitors and phone calls were not tallied during 2021 due to limited staff resources

## **Shelter Services**

- 568 companion animals were cared for at the shelter facility
- 531 companion animals were new arrivals to the shelter
- 454 companion animals were adopted
- 495 shelter animals underwent surgery (spays/neuters, dentals, minor surgeries)
- 22 animals (dogs, cats, guinea pigs) were surrendered through area Animal Control Officers and/or Law Enforcement agencies
- 120 vaccines (rabies and distemper) were administered at the public vaccine clinic

## **Community Programs**

- 550 cats were spayed/neutered through SNAP\*
  - o 520 owned/pet cats
  - o 30 rescued community cats from *Hearts of Nine* feline rescue
- 34 community cats were spayed/neutered through TNR\*\*
- 177 dogs were spayed/neutered through SNAP\*
  - o 40 completed onsite at SCAC
  - o 137 completed offsite by participating area veterinarians
- 252 pets were fed through the Pet Food Pantry
  - o 147 bags of dog food
  - o 132 bags of cat food
  - o 71 bags of cat litter
  - o 69 families accessed the program
- 14 pets received emergency veterinary care through our Angel Fund Program
- 95 volunteers contributed more than 1,200 hours to shelter operations
  - o 56 adult and youth volunteers spent 642 hours at the shelter
  - o 24 volunteers spent 600 hours providing short-term foster care to kittens
  - o 15 volunteers opened their homes to provide long-term, daily foster care to dogs and cats with chronic illnesses
