



Community Impact Report 2021

General Information

- A total of **1,715** companion animals were provided care and services through SCAC
- A total of 1,119 surgeries were completed onsite by staff veterinarians
- Note: Visitors and phone calls were not tallied during 2021 due to limited staff resources

Shelter Services

- **568** companion animals were cared for at the shelter facility
- 531 companion animals were new arrivals to the shelter
- 454 companion animals were adopted
- 495 shelter animals underwent surgery (spays/neuters, dentals, minor surgeries)
- 22 animals (dogs, cats, guinea pigs) were surrendered through area Animal Control Officers and/or Law Enforcement agencies
- **120** vaccines (rabies and distemper) were administered at the public vaccine clinic

Community Programs

- **550** cats were spayed/neutered through SNAP*
 - 520 owned/pet cats
 - 30 rescued community cats from *Hearts of Nine* feline rescue
- **34** community cats were spayed/neutered through TNR**
- **177** dogs were spayed/neutered through SNAP*
 - 40 completed onsite at SCAC
 - 137 completed offsite by participating area veterinarians
- **252** pets were fed through the Pet Food Pantry
 - 147 bags of dog food
 - 132 bags of cat food
 - 71 bags of cat litter
 - 69 families accessed the program
- **14** pets received emergency veterinary care through our Angel Fund Program
- 95 volunteers contributed more than 1,200 hours to shelter operations
 - 56 adult and youth volunteers spent 642 hours at the shelter
 - 24 volunteers spent 600 hours providing short-term foster care to kittens
 - 15 volunteers opened their homes to provide long-term, daily foster care to dogs and cats with chronic illnesses
