

## Community Impact Report 2022

## **General Information**

- A total of 1,770 companion animals were provided care and services through SCAC
- A total of 962 surgeries were completed onsite by staff veterinarians
- A total of 6,382 people visited the shelter and 5,615 phone calls were received

## **Shelter Services**

- 568 companion animals were cared for at the shelter facility
- 526 companion animals were new arrivals to the shelter
- 467 companion animals were adopted
- 424 shelter animals underwent surgery (spays/neuters, dentals, minor surgeries)
- 10 animals (dogs and cats) were surrendered through area Animal Control Officers and/or Law Enforcement agencies
- 116 vaccines (rabies and distemper) were administered at the public vaccine clinics

## **Community Programs**

- 465 cats were spayed/neutered through SNAP\*
  - o 459 owned/pet cats
  - o 6 community cats from *Hearts of Nine* feline rescue
- 42 community cats were spayed/neutered through TNR\*\*
- 147 dogs were spayed/neutered through SNAP\*
  - o 31 completed onsite at SCAC
  - o 116 completed offsite by participating area veterinarians
- 407 pets were fed through our Pet Food Pantry
  - o 340 bags of dog food
  - o 339 bags of cat food
  - o 124 bags of cat litter
  - o 102 families accessed this program
- 25 pets received emergency veterinary care through our Angel Fund Program
- 127 volunteers contributed more than 4,510 hours to shelter operations
  - o 111 adult and youth volunteers spent 1,098 hours at the shelter
  - o 11 volunteers spent 952 hours providing short-term foster care to kittens
  - o 5 volunteers opened their homes to provide long-term, daily foster care to dogs (2) and cats (3) with chronic conditions that prevent them from being adopted
