

## Community Impact Report 2023

## **General Information**

- A total of 1,934 companion animals were provided care and services through SCAC
- A total of 1,015 surgeries were completed onsite by staff veterinarians
- A total of 8,007 people visited the shelter and 5,791 phone calls were received

## **Shelter Services**

- 592 companion animals were cared for at the shelter facility
- 507 companion animals were new arrivals to the shelter
- 383 companion animals were adopted
- 441 shelter animals underwent surgery (spays/neuters, dentals, minor surgeries)
- 7 animals were surrendered through Animal Control Officers and/or Law Enforcement
- 111 vaccines (rabies and distemper) were administered at the public vaccine clinics
- 9 microchips and registrations were completed at the public microchip clinic

## **Community Programs**

- 514 cats were spayed/neutered through SNAP\*
- 23 community cats were spayed/neutered through TNR\*\*
- 116 dogs were spayed/neutered through SNAP\*
  - o 37 completed onsite at SCAC
  - o 79 completed offsite by participating area veterinarians
- 504 pets were fed through our Pet Food Pantry
  - o 349 bags of dog food
  - o 385 bags of cat food
  - o 93 bags of cat litter
  - 135 households accessed this program
- 65 pets received emergency veterinary care through our Angel Fund Program
- 192 volunteers contributed 3,700 hours to shelter operations
  - o 181 adult and youth volunteers spent 2,352 hours at the shelter
  - o 11 volunteers spent 1,348 hours providing short-term foster care to kittens
  - 4 volunteers opened their homes to provide long-term, daily foster care to dogs
    (2), cats (1), and critters (1) with chronic conditions that prevent them from being adopted
