

## Community Impact Report 2024

## **General Information**

- A total of 1,744 companion animals were provided care and services through SCAC
- A total of 903 surgeries were completed onsite by staff veterinarians
- A total of 8,335 people visited the shelter and 4,848 phone calls were received

## **Shelter Services**

- 515 companion animals were cared for at the shelter facility
- 451 companion animals were new arrivals to the shelter
- 409 companion animals were adopted
- 430 shelter animals underwent surgery (spays/neuters, dentals, minor surgeries)
- 18 animals were surrendered through Animal Control Officers and/or Law Enforcement
- 256 vaccines (rabies and distemper) and 10 microchips were administered at the public vaccine/microchip clinics

## **Community Programs**

- 383 cats were spayed/neutered through SNAP\*
- 48 community cats were spayed/neutered through TNR\*\*
- 93 dogs were spayed/neutered through SNAP\*
  - o 42 completed onsite at SCAC
  - o 51 completed offsite by participating area veterinarians
- 407 pets were fed through our Pet Food Pantry
  - o 249 bags of dog food
  - o 251 bags of cat food
  - o 49 bags of cat litter
  - o 102 households accessed this program
- 27 pets received emergency veterinary care through our Angel Fund Program
- 216 volunteers contributed **4,060 hours** to shelter operations
  - o 160 adult and youth volunteers spent 1,400 hours at the shelter
  - o 21 volunteers spent 2,480 hours providing short-term foster care to kittens
  - o 30 volunteers spent 180 hours working on special projects
  - 5 volunteers opened their homes to provide long-term, daily foster care to dogs
    (2) and cats (3) with chronic conditions that prevent them from being adopted
