



Community Impact Report 2025

General Information

- A total of **1,560** companion animals were provided care and services through SCAC
- A total of 924 surgeries were completed onsite by staff veterinarians
- A total of 7,487 people visited the shelter and 3,969 phone calls were received

Shelter Services

- **425** companion animals were cared for at the shelter facility
- 362 companion animals were new arrivals to the shelter
- 338 companion animals were adopted
- 327 shelter animals underwent surgery (spays/neuters, dentals, minor surgeries)
- 10 animals were surrendered through Animal Control Officers and/or Law Enforcement
- **241** vaccines (rabies and distemper) and **33** microchips were administered at the public vaccine/microchip clinics

Community Programs

- **434** cats were spayed/neutered through SNAP*
- **106** community cats were spayed/neutered through TNR**
- **104** dogs were spayed/neutered through SNAP*
 - 57 completed onsite at SCAC
 - 47 completed offsite by participating area veterinarians
- **197** pets were fed through our Pet Food Pantry
 - 172 bags of dog food
 - 130 bags of cat food
 - 17 bags of cat litter
 - 34 households accessed this program
- **17** pets received emergency veterinary care through our *Angel Fund Program*
- 170 volunteers contributed **5,140 hours** to shelter operations
 - 111 adult and youth volunteers spent **1,830 hours** at the shelter
 - 16 volunteers spent **2,590 hours** providing short-term foster care to kittens
 - 41 volunteers spent **720 hours** working on special projects
 - 2 volunteers opened their homes to provide long-term, daily foster care to **3** cats with chronic conditions that prevent them from being adopted
